SOS Dress Code

- We expect all of our staff and participants to dress modestly. The SOS fulltime staff may ask you or an Adult Leader to consult a camper if they are dressed inappropriately.
- No sandals or open-toed shoes on the work site; tennis shoes or boots only, (Toms are not sufficient)
- No spaghetti straps, tank tops or cut off t-shirts for guys or girls at any time
- No shorts will be allowed at the worksites. We ask that all participants wear long pants. Sturdier pants like jeans are encouraged on the worksite. Leggings/yoga pants are strongly discouraged.
- In the evenings we ask that girls wear shorts that are longer than their fingertips. Please advise your students to bring only appropriate length shorts.
