

Notice of Privacy Practices

This privacy notice discloses the privacy practices for Service Over Self, Inc. (SOS) and it applies solely to information collected by this website. It is designed to notify you of the following:

1. What personally identifiable information is collected from you through the website, how it is used and with whom it may be shared.
2. What choices are available to you regarding the use of your data.
3. The security procedures in place to protect the misuse of your information.
4. How you can correct any inaccuracies in the information.

Information Collection, Use, and Sharing

We are the sole owners of the information collected on this site. We only have access to or collect information that you voluntarily give us. *We will not sell or rent this information to anyone; however, we may utilize third party vendors to manage and secure data at rest and in transit.* We utilize the information you provide to us to process your registration, keep you informed as to our events and offerings and we may solicit donations for our continued mission.

We will use your information to respond to you regarding the reason you contacted us. *We will not share your information with any third party outside of our organization, other than as necessary to fulfill your request, such as to provide information or include you in current activities.*

Unless you ask us not to, we may contact you via telephone, email, text messaging, snap-chat, twitter, or otherwise in the future to tell you about specials, services, fund drives, sponsorship opportunities or other related information, as well as changes to this privacy policy.

Your Access to and Control Over Information

You may opt out of any future contacts from us at any time. You can do the following at any time by contacting us at office@sosmemphis.org :

- See what data we have about you, if any.
- Change/correct any data we have about you.
- Have us delete any data we have about you.
- Express any concern you have about our use of your data.

Security

We take precautions to protect your information. When you submit sensitive information via the website, your information is protected both online and offline.

Wherever we collect sensitive information (such as personal data) that information is encrypted and transmitted to us in a secure way. You can verify this by looking for a lock icon in the address bar and looking for "https" at the beginning of the address of the Web page.

While we use encryption to protect sensitive information transmitted online, we also protect your information offline. Only employees who need the information to perform a specific job (for example, credit card numbers and social security numbers) are granted access to personally identifiable information. The computers/servers in which we store personally identifiable information are kept in a secure environment.

In order to engage with us, you must first complete the registration form. During registration a user is required to give certain information (such as name and email address). This information is used to hold or confirm a registration and to allow us to contact you about the services on our site in which you have expressed interest.

We request information from you on our registration forms, applications, and liability waivers. To participate in what we are doing or offering, you must provide contact information (like name, address, and other contact information) and, if necessary, financial information (like credit card number, expiration date). This information is used for billing purposes and to complete your transaction. If we have trouble processing a request or payment, we'll use this information to contact you.

Cookies

We use "cookies" on this site. A cookie is a piece of data stored on a site visitor's hard drive to help us improve your access to our site and identify repeat visitors to our site. For instance, when we use a cookie to identify you, you would not have to log in a password more than once, thereby saving time while on our site. Cookies can also enable us to track and target the interests of our users to enhance the experience on our site. Usage of a cookie is in no way linked to any personally identifiable information on our site.

We use an outside company to maintain contact with you, and a credit card processing company to bill users or collect payment for services. These companies do not retain, share, store or use your personally identifiable information for any secondary purposes beyond storing or processing our data.
